THE GOSPEL OF JOHN Chapter 2

INTRODUCTION...

In Chapter Two of the Gospel of John we begin to look at the beginning of Jesus' ministry. We will be specifically looking at three things; Jesus' first miracle, Jesus' act of 'righteous anger', and the 'omniscience' of Jesus.

Be aware that in the remaining studies you may be asked to do additional research beyond that which is in the bible. For instance, in this study, you will be required to look up definitions in the dictionary. It is important that we always look up words that we don't understand. This will help us to have the best possible understanding of the Scriptures.

Be sure that you read the questions carefully to make sure that you have answered the complete question. You will notice that some of the questions have more than one part to them.

Remember that you will be using the Inductive Bible Study (IBS) method of study. Which means that in each study you will be required to make observations, interpretations and application of what you have observed and interpreted. (see further explanation in Study #1)
